

The following tax exemptions are available to North Smithfield residents who qualify.

1. **Veterans:** Residents must have served during war time and must provide us with a copy of their DD 214 and a copy of their driver's license. Residents must come to the Assessor's Office to sign the form in person. If necessary, we will pick up the form at their home and take their DD 214 and driver's license, make a copy, and bring it back.

2. **Senior Exemption:** Residents must be 65 years old as of December 31, 2008 and must be a North Smithfield resident for a minimum of 3 years. They must provide a copy of their driver's license and if married, a copy of their spouse's driver's license. Also, they must come in person to sign the form at the Assessor's Office. If necessary, we will pick up the form at their home and take their driver's license to make a copy and bring it back.

3. **Disability:** Residents must be totally disabled and declared so by Social Security. They must provide a copy of the letter stating that they are disabled as well as a driver's license. Residents must be under 65 years old and have been a resident for at least 3 years. If necessary, we will pick up the form at their home and take their driver's license and letter of disability to make a copy and bring it back.

The Senior Exemption and Disability Exemption is \$500.00 off your taxes. You cannot claim both. The Veteran's Exemption may go on your motor vehicle or home not both. The exemption is \$45.50 off real estate taxes or \$45.50 off motor vehicle taxes.
