Code of Ordinances

(Sec.6-3A.)

Exemptions from real property tax for persons sixty-five years of age and older.

Every person, a citizen and resident of the town, of the age 65 years or more and residing in the town for a period of three years ending with the date of assessment (December 31) in real property situated in said town owned and occupied by him or her, is hereby granted on proper claim being made therefore, a tax exemption on the following basis: {Only 1 senior exemption per parcel.}

- (a) For property owners from 65 years of age or more, an exemption from taxation on such real property of \$500.00.
