A Brief History

Heritage Hall was built in 1897 as a chapel for the St. Luke's Episcopal Mission serving a congregation of families from the Slatersville textile mills. After the relocation of the mills to the south, the building was sold in 1906 and became a community hall called Lincoln Hall. In 1913 it was sold to the Union Grange #13 and was known as Grange Hall until 1994, when it was given to the No. Smithfield Heritage Association and was re-named the Heritage Hall.

Since 1994 the No. Smithfield Heritage Association has been gradually renovating, expanding, and refurbishing this building to enable it to serve as a central historical community center. Although there is still work to be done, the building is now available for community use.
